Sons of Portugal Scholarship High School Application

Eligibility Requirements:

Students have to be of **Portuguese descent** living at least one full year in Danbury or its surrounding areas. Scholarships will be granted to any accredited educational institution up to a maximum of four years per recipient.

Other Requirements:

In order to be considered, all the following requirements must be met (failure to comply will affect the applicant's eligibility and/or his/her final ranking):

- 1. Document(s) supporting the applicant's Portuguese descent (birth certificate(s), passport(s), Portuguese Identification Card (Bilhete de Identidade/ Cartão de Cidadão) or any other documentation of proof that meets with the Committee's satisfaction);
- 2. Two (2) **current** letters of recommendation (one from a school official, another from a community member);
- Completed application postmarked by April 11th, 2020 including:
 - Official high school transcript
 - Detailed resume, which includes all service and/or completed/awarded within the last 4 years.
 - Subheadings of the resume should include: Honors and Awards, Portuguese Community Service, Community Service/Activities, School Service/Extra-Curricular Activities, Work Experience, and Sports and Recreation Activities. (See sample)
 - Sample resume is recommended.
 - Copy of any awards or certificates listed in resume.
 - Official letter(s) and/or documentation for all items listed on resume. All documentation should directly come from an advisor, director, or head of the organization, their contact information, signature and date. (Unofficial and/or unverified service will not qualify)
 - Sample form letter for community/service attached
 - Copy of the applicant's Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) *
 - Please note activities cannot be listed in multiple headings.
